

INTRODUCTION

Titan Owners Club and NOVA are teaming up to bring you three amazing “Floorhammer” events, showcasing the biggest and baddest of the 40k universe’s monstrosities: Titans. Join us in two events as Titans, Knights, and other powerful machines of war battle for supremacy. Participation Requirements As this event is hosted by the Titan Owners Club blog, all participating models must be of Citadel or Forge World origin. This means that 3-D prints, recasts, and Armorcast Titans are not supported for these events. Note that unique prints or conversions for weapons, or bespoke conversions for head and armor plates, not created in “full scale” (i.e., 28mm scale) are acceptable so long as the model's main body are Citadel or Forge World products. Certificates and proof of purchase will not be required; however, Titan Owners Club reserves the right to remove models suspected of not being authentic and will also act in accordance with NOVA Open policies.

Models must be fully painted to a minimum three-color standard.

Models Allowed

The Titan Owners Club National event allows all Knights, Titans, and Titanic models that have the VEHICLE keyword (sorry, no daemons or Primarchs), using the most recently available Warhammer 40,000 rulesets published by Games Workshop and Imperial Armour. Models with FLYER may not be used for this event. Let the Titans Hit the Floor is played with Adeptus Titanicus rules in “full scale”; however, we will expand the models that may be used in the event dependent upon the popularity of certain models and the amount of time we can devote to crafting custom command terminals. WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING

Players are responsible for their own models, dice, and tape measures. The templates needed for the Adeptus Titanicus ruleset event will be provided by Titan Owners Club. Custom terminals will be provided if time and resources permit.

PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Players are responsible for their own models, books, dice, and other accessories.
 - a. You **MUST** possess an official print, or digital (40k App) copy of any rules used by your forces.
 - b. Player responsibility for their materials will be strictly enforced due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and players may not handle someone else's items unless given express permission to do so.
2. Players are expected to behave in a dignified and civilized manner, including maintaining the cleanliness of the facilities and respectful attitude towards spectators, TOC, and NOVA Open.
 - a. This extends to excessive profanity and/or discriminatory language or gestures.

Warhammer 40k-Grand Narrative-Machinations Unbound This is a unique event where there will be three sides fighting for control. Please register for the side that you are wanting to support, Titan, under control of the mad Magus, Obitus Exitum or Salus Preatus. Each player is restricted to a maximum of 3 Titans and up to 2500 points of units that have the Titanic or Super-Heavy keyword, or the Monster/Vehicle keyword with at least one weapon with a strength of 14. All vehicles of the same class will be grouped into a squadron that will share a wound pool and must retain 6" unit coherency. Units that end a players turn out of unit coherency are destroyed.
